Participants are required to book their own flight. This allows participants to add days befor and/or after and select air line and ticket conditions.

One option is a flight from Schipol International Airport, Netherlands to Soekarno Hatta International Airport Indonesia with Garuda Indonesian Airways (direct flight 13 hr), departing 12.05 Schiphol, arriving Jakarta 06.55 (+1day).



1. Special Notice: Flight Booking Assistance and Limitation of Liability

- Please note that Bersukaria Tour only assists clients in booking their domestic flights within Indonesia. Please be advised that Bersukaria Tour is not responsible for damages, losses, or additional costs resulting from flight delays, cancellations, or changes in flight schedules. This includes, but is not limited to, missed International flight and Domestic flight connections, accommodations, or scheduled activities.
- We strongly recommend that clients secure comprehensive travel insurance to cover any unforeseen disruptions.
- You as our clients/agents are acknowledge and accept this condition as part of our terms and conditions.

2. Booking Confirmation and Payment:

- The Indische Genealogie Vereeniging (IGV) act as our partner in this trip and their order serves as confirmation of the booking to all services mentioned as above.
- Clients have to fulfilled the payment by the end of 2024 for 75% from the total amount and have to pay the rest 25% maximum D-2 weeks prior for the tour date
- All services with Bersukaria Touris PREPAID, NON-REFUNDABLE





3. Cancellation and Refunds:

- All services booked with Bersukaria Tour CANNOT BE MODIFIED, TRANSFERRED, CANCELLED OR REPLACED without prior written agreement from Bersukaria Tour and IGV
- Services that are not used or cancelled due to certain situations beyond human control such as pandemic diseases, natural disasters or emergencies are non refundable regardless of what may be said or written by local suppliers, hotel staff or other employees. Unless official approved in written by Bersukaria Tour as tour operator

4. Changes and Amendments

- Procedures for making changes to bookings, such as changing dates or number of tourists, must be carried out directly where clients make bookings. Indonesia Impression Tour will not make changes to the tour even if requested by clients without prior approval where the client has made a previous booking.
- All costs related to changes or amendments will be borne by the guest directly with prior approval





5. Travel Documents, Bali Levy and Responsibilities:

- Clients are responsible for ensuring they possess valid travel documents such as passports with minimum 6 months validity, visas to Indonesia where for non visa on arrival countries must apply latest 14 days before arrival in Indonesia, and health certificates before travelling to Indonesia.
- All clients must be responsible for valid travel documents such as passports and visas which are required and will be the client's own responsibility while traveling in Indonesia.
- Bali Levy is a mandatory fee imposed on visitors to the Indonesian island of Bali at IDR.150.000. It is typically collected upon arrival in Bali whether by Air, Sea or Land transportation and is intended to support the preservation and development of Bali tourism-related infrastructure and environmental initiatives.
- The tour operator is not liable for any consequences resulting from clients' failure to obtain necessary travel documents such as Visa to enter Indonesia.

6. Insurance:

- Clients are encouraged to purchase travel insurance covering trip cancellations, medical emergencies, and other unforeseen events before travel to Indonesia
- Client may book optional insurance packages to Indonesia including details with advance request to Indonesia Impression Tour.

9. Force Majeure:
